The time is approaching quickly for our trip to the Chile. There are a few things that you need to know for the Team's upcoming trip to Chile in January. This is the first update for our trip. There will be others so check your email regularly.

The web page for this trip is found at www.TeamORH.Com. Please check weekly for updates.

1. Please look for the attached Standard Operating Procedures Manuel. This is how we operate our clinics. Please read thoroughly.
2. You should have received your e-tickets in your inbox from our travel agent, Elaine Ashton. Your tickets will fly you in and out of Puerto Montt.
 - a. If you did not receive yours, please notify me immediately.
 - b. Please check the following on your ticket and immediately notify me of any errors.
 - i. Name as it is on your passport
 - ii. Departure and Return Airport
 - iii. Departure and Return Dates (Jan 27 -Feb4)

If you have not made your payments for the trip please mail it now to the Fayetteville address.

Please make checks payable to Operation Renewed Hope and mark all checks clearly "Preferred for (Name of Trip) (Name of Participant)."

3. We are making ID cards for each team member. If you have not been on one of the trips in the last two or three years please email me a head shot picture of yourself for this card. This can be a selfie taken with your camera and emailed to me. Please do this today before you forget. If you were on one of those trips you will use the same ID and Insurance cards (insurance card are only valid for one year) so make sure you can locate them.
4. Also make sure you have had your Hepatitis A and B vaccines.
5. CDC recommends a current rabies shot and typhoid vaccine.
6. **We will spend a night in Puerto Montt on our arrival and return. You will need to pack your carryon for those nights as you may not have access to your checked**

luggage until arrival on the island. If we do have access, you will hold up the entire team if you have to get in your checked luggage.

7. ORH provides medical and emergency evacuation insurance. Trip Interruption Insurance is not a part of this but is recommended for these trips. The following are two companies that offer it and were recommended to us. Check them out and compare coverages.

8. You will need to exchange your spending money when you arrive at the airport in Santiago. I would recommend \$50.00 unless you plan to buy a lot of souvenirs.
9. We will stay in a "rustic" hotel in Puerto Montt. You will need a sheet and a towel.
10. The electrical outlets in Peru looks like the US but it is 220v.
11. Here is a list of items you need to pack in addition the items listed in the SOP manual(page 40):
 - a. Your Bible
 - b. Flashlight
 - c. Toilet paper
 - d. Sun Screen & Insect repellent.
